

I had been working on this concept when I found this nice <u>picture of planet relative sizes</u>. Taking the <u>orbits from there</u> I was able to draw a view of the "Earth plane" relative to Ceres' 10.6 degrees orbit inclination and oh! Pareidolia.

So far the orbital idea seems the most fruitful. The <u>Heliospheric Current Sheet</u> is a great mix of spiral and orbits, but it should be extended to match a whole disk because this form (link) doesn't look good enough. I intended to use <u>this picture</u> as a placeholder logo FWIW.
